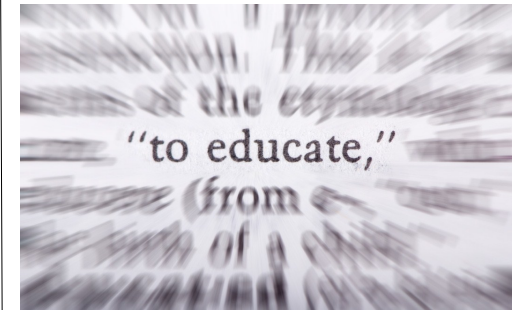

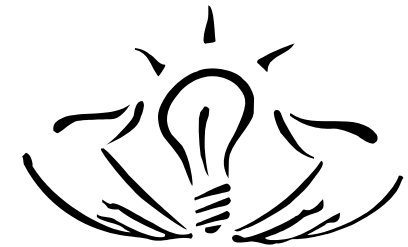
Program Goal
